## Where are the venues?

The full-time twenty week course will operate from four centres across Cornwall but based mainly at Porthpean in mid Cornwall. A week will be spent at the Roseland Centre for the R.Y.A. Powerboat qualifications with two days at Carnyorth Environmental Education Centre looking at sustainability and other opportunities for outdoor learning. The course will also incorporate time at Delaware Centre, near Dartmoor, for a number of the land-based courses.
